LINSTOW BALTIC STARTS TO DEVELOP A NEW OFFICE CENTER IN RIGA; SIGNS A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH SEB LATVIA

Linstow Baltic has started the development of a new large-scale office complex in the

vicinity of the Riga Railway Station and the Origo One business center between Elizabetes,

Ernesta Birznieka-Upīša, Satekles and Dzirnavu streets. In October of this year a lease

agreement was signed with SEB Latvia for their new headquarter, which will thus become

the anchor tenant of the new development. The opening is planned for 2025.

The future modern office complex will be integrated into the city's historical heritage buildings

and will combine high quality standards and excellent sustainability indicators, creating a

modern working environment for both future employees and visitors. The environmentally

friendly office project will be located close to shopping centers, hotels, various entertainment

facilities and other daily services including all means of public transport. It is planned that the

building will have 6-8 floors, with an area of approximately 12,000 m<sup>2</sup>.

Linstow Baltic CEO Frode Grønvold:

"The cooperation agreement between SEB Latvia and Linstow Baltic is an excellent

acknowledgement of Linstow's strategic vision for the surroundings of Riga Central Railway

Station as one of the most important strategic transportation nodes and business development

areas in Latvia. SEB's headquarter in the area will further reinforce the strategic importance of

this location and pave the way for more office developments as well as retail- and service

functions in its surroundings. The cooperation also underpins the importance of both

companies' commitments to sustainability."

The application for the design competition for the new office complex has now been completed.

The purpose of the design contest is to obtain an urban, architecturally thought-thru design for

the new sustainable office building complex. The design should include architectural solutions

and the site's joint master plan for the creation of a complex of office buildings on three

interlinked land plots.
